How long should my CKA take?

This will very much depend on how much time you want to spend completing it and your own background knowledge of Primary education.

How many resources should I read?

We recommend that you read two per question to help support you to effectively critique an idea or concept. You may decide that you want to spend longer reading and researching the concepts contained within all the resources on offer. You shouldn't feel pressured to read and understand every resource. Instead, select resources you feel are most interesting and useful for you.

How do I decide which resources to select?

This is up to you. We recognise that our participants start the program with hugely varied experience and so it is up to you to decide how you want to develop and extend your thinking. We suggest that where possible, you select resources that you may be less familiar with, in order to broaden your knowledge and experience of ideas and concepts about which you are less familiar.

Why are there no recommended resources for question 4?

Within question 4 you may wish to refer to resources you have used for other questions, for example question 1's resources include the National Curriculum; these could be used again in thinking about your response to question 4.
